[LAFCO-04-04](#): North Sanborn Drainage District Reorganization and Sphere of Influence Amendment - A reorganization of territory proposing to annex 30 acres to the Gilsizer County Drainage District and detach the property from the Tierra Buena County Drainage District. The purpose of the proposal is to allow development on the subject 30 acres to be provided drainage services by the Gilsizer District. In addition, the spheres of influence for each district are proposed to be amended to reflect the jurisdictional boundary change. The affected territory is located at the southeast corner of the intersection of Cherry Street and Sanborn Road.

[LAFCO-03-12](#): Fairview Cemetery District Municipal Service Review and Sphere of Influence Update. In accordance with Government Code Section 56425(f), Sutter LAFCO is conducting a municipal service review and sphere of influence update for the Fairview Cemetery District. The review evaluates the services provided by the District, its service area and service needs as well as its sphere of influence.

[LAFCO-04-05](#): Consideration to adopt a resolution authorizing the Executive Officer to carry-out public hearings for Conducting Authority proceedings on behalf of the Commission pursuant to Government Code Section 57000(c).
