

## RESOLUTION NO. 2006-01

### RESOLUTION OF THE SUTTER COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY, FORMATION COMMISSION, ACTING AS THE CONDUCTING AUTHORITY, MAKING DETERMINATIONS ON THE VALUE OF WRITTEN PROTEST FOR THE REORGANIZATION OF TERRITORY DESIGNATED AS TATLA/WALKER REORGANIZATION NO. 326

#### RECITALS

1. On October 27 and December 1, 2005, the Sutter County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) held public hearings to consider a reorganization of territory to annex 395± acres to the City of Yuba City, and detachment of the property from County Service Area “G” and the Consolidated Street Lighting District.
2. After conducting public hearings and considering all evidence, both written and oral, LAFCO adopted Resolution No. 2005-10, approving the reorganization on December 1, 2005.
3. On January 4, 2006, the Executive Officer provided notice of the conducting authority proceedings in accordance with Government Code Section 57025(a).
4. On January 26, 2006, the Executive Officer, acting on behalf of the Commission as the conducting authority, held a protest hearing and received all oral and written protests filed against the reorganization.

THEREFORE, THE SUTTER COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION RESOLVES THAT:

1. Valid written protests to the reorganization in accordance with Government Code Section 57075(a) (2) (A) and (B) were not filed. An election is not required.
2. A majority written protest to the reorganization in accordance with Government Code Section 57078 was not filed.
3. The reorganization, which annexes 395± acres to the City of Yuba City and detachment of the land from County Service Area “G” and the Consolidated Street Lighting District, is approved.
4. The boundaries of the reorganization area are shown on Exhibit “A” which is attached.
5. This action is taken pursuant to division 3, title 5 (commencing with section 56000) of the Government Code, known as the Cotese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000.

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6. The terms and conditions of the reorganization are set forth in LAFCO Resolution No. 2005-10, and incorporated herein by reference.

7. The reasons for the reorganization are those set forth in the statement of reasons included in the LAFCO Executive Officer's staff reports for the meetings of October 27 and December 1, 2005, hereby incorporated herein by reference.

8. The regular Sutter County assessment roll will be utilized in connection with this reorganization.

9. The affected territory will not be taxed for existing general bonded indebtedness of any agency whose boundaries are changed by this reorganization.
