Re: **LAFCO #05-03: Certificate of Termination for the Tatla/Walker Reorganization No. 326**

**I. STAFF'S RECOMMENDED ACTION**

Adopt the attached Resolution No. 2006-06 terminating the proceedings for the Tatla/Walker Reorganization No. 326.

**II. BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

LAFCO approved the Tatla/Walker Reorganization No. 326 on December 1, 2005, and held conducting authority proceedings on January 26, 2006. It was determined that valid registered voter protest against the proposal had been filed. As a result, an election was required in order to approve the proposal.

On June 6, 2006, registered voters, living within the reorganization area, cast ballots on the matter. Of a total of 246 ballots cast, 139 persons (56.5%) voted against the measure (Measure Q) while 107 persons (43.5%) voted in favor of the measure.

Government Code Section 57179 states that if the majority of the votes cast are against a change of organization or reorganization, the commission shall execute a certificate of termination for the proceedings. In addition, Government Code Section 57090 states that no substantially similar proposal for a change of organization or reorganization of the same or substantially the same territory may be filed with the commission within one year.
