5. Public Hearings.

a. [LAFCO-03-03](#): A reorganization of territory designated as the South Yuba City Reorganization No. 315. Yuba City has submitted a Resolution of Application to LAFCO proposing to annex 823 acres of land to the City and detach the property from County Service Area G and the Consolidated Street Lighting District. The affected territory lies along State Highway 99 from Franklin Road south to Bogue Road and between Walton Avenue on the West and Railroad/Bunce Roads on the East.

b. [LAFCO-00-04](#): A reorganization of territory designated as the South Highway 20 Reorganization No. 302 that proposes to annex 110.5 acres to Yuba City and detach the property from County Service Area G. The affected territory is located southeast of the intersection of El Margarita Road and Highway 20 and includes those lands lying east of El Margarita Road to Lassen Boulevard and the existing city limits. The area of reorganization may be enlarged by the Commission to include all unincorporated lands lying west of the above described territory and extending to and around Industrial Drive. The enlarged territory boundaries total 220 acres.
