**5. Public Hearings.**

a. [LAFCO-00-04](#): A reorganization of territory designated as the South Highway 20 Reorganization No. 302. Sutter LAFCO has received two filings for reconsideration for its resolution adopted on September 25, 2003, approving the above annexation.

The first filing requests that LAFCO reconsider the annexation boundary approved and asks that all lands located east of and including the Calvary Temple Church located at 2620 Colusa Highway be included in annexation.

The second filing for reconsideration requests that LAFCO enlarge the annexation boundary to include all unincorporated lands lying west of El Margarita Road and extending to and around Industrial Drive. This enlarged boundary was previously considered by the Commission on September 25, 2003.

b. [LAFCO-03-03](#): A reorganization of territory designated as the South Yuba City Reorganization No. 315. Sutter LAFCO has received a filing for reconsideration for its resolution adopted on September 25, 2003, approving the South Yuba City Reorganization. The filing requests LAFCO to reconsider its decision to include Assessor's Parcel 22-072-043, comprising 12.73 acres, and located at 1146 Lincoln Road in the annexation and asks that this parcel be excluded from the reorganization.

c. [LAFCO-03-08](#): In accordance with Government Code Section 56425(f), Sutter LAFCO is conducting a municipal service review and sphere of influence update for the Sutter Cemetery District. The review evaluates the services provided by the District, its service area, and current and future service needs within the District.
